MOSAIC works to protect and ensure the rights of LGBTIQ persons on national, regional and local levels, including police stations, detention centers, and workplaces.

Urgent interventions to restore LGBTIQ rights through policy reform and legal aid are needed in Lebanon due to: The Penal code 534 criminalizing which criminalizes homosexuality in Lebanon, the ongoing forced virginity and anal tests in certain police stations, arbitrary termination of work and lease contracts on the basis of LGBTIQ status, hate speech and death threats among other homophobic/sexist actions.

Cases of severe marginalization and/or life threatening situations that cannot be handled locally due to legal policies in Lebanon are followed up by our Senior Social Worker and referred to the UNHCR offices in Lebanon in order to ensure proper protection and wellbeing.
